Home Trial Support (HTS) is an innovative approach in clinical research that enables patients to participate in trials from the comfort of their own homes. By minimizing the need for frequent travel to clinical sites, HTS not only improves patient convenience but also increases accessibility for those with mobility issues and reduces overall patient burdens that come with traditional trials. This approach has the potential to enhance patient retention and patient recruitment, while also reducing the burden on healthcare facilities. HTS is particularly valuable in studies requiring long-term follow-up or complex treatments, as it offers a flexible and patient-centered solution.

The use of home based chemotherapy was mandatory in this phase 2, oncology study from a global sponsor. Enrollment was estimated at 12 months, assuming uptake would be rapid due the availability of chemotherapy in the home. Without using Home Trial Support, estimated enrollment time for this type of clinical would have been 25% – 50% longer.

Results

- Enrollment completed in 11 months; 1 month ahead of target
- Recruitment 40% faster compared to the estimated recruitment period without the use of Home Trial Support
- Average number of patients recruited per site, per month was significantly higher than the industry average


